As per the recent communication via our Newsletter and ParentPay, Year 2 children will be going on a trip to the Castle Keep in Newcastle as part of their history topic, The New Castle on Wednesday 29th March. Children have been thoroughly enjoying this topic so far, learning about castles and key information about the castle which gave the city its name. While visiting the castle, the children will complete a tour, learn about what life was like in a medieval castle and take part in the knight school workshop, where they will learn all about how to be a medieval knight. Children will get first-hand experience of walking the historical castle as well as observing artefacts to really support their historical understanding.
