Year 4/5 Trip to Moor House Adventure Centre

9th May 2023

Dear Parent/Carer,

On Monday 5th June 2023, Year 4/5 class will be completing an extended day at Moor House Adventure Centre in Durham. Children will have the opportunity to challenge themselves, take part in team challenges, building on social and communication skills and develop their ability to critically analyse and problem solve. The children will leave school at 9.30am and head to Moor House, where they will spend the day completing the following activities:

- Archery
- Team building activities
- Crate stacking
- Cave Bus
- The Cube (leap of faith)
- Campfire with songs and tea

Children will have tea at Moor House around a campfire before leaving the site at 5.30pm to arrive back at school for a 6pm pick up. This trip is an excellent opportunity for your child to try new skills and push themselves beyond their comfort zones in new challenges. All of the activities will be carried out by trained staff who work at the adventure centre and children will be fitted with the correct safety equipment for tasks which require it.

For the trip, children will need to come to school in suitable clothing for the activities listed which will not be uniform. Children should wear long joggers or leggings, long-sleeved tops (t-shirts can be worn underneath), sensible outdoor footwear such as trainers or walking boots which you do not mind getting dirty or damaged. Children should also pack a spare pair of clothes with them in case they get wet or muddy from some of the activities and need to change. It may be hot weather so please think about your child dressing for warmer weather with a hat and sun cream if needed.

As well as suitable clothing, children will need to bring a packed lunch with them and a refillable water bottle as there are fountains available on site to fill up with fresh water. If your child is in receipt of means tested free school meals a packed lunch can be provided by the school kitchen. Please specify this on ParentPay. Tea before they leave the site will be provided to the children so please let us know any dietary requirements your child has via ParentPay.

The cost of this extended activity day is £49 per child. This can be paid in full or you can make one payment of £29 and a second payment of £20. Consent and full payment must be received via ParentPay by Friday 2^{nd} June 2023.
