Dear Parents and Carers,

On Friday 6th December 2024, Year 1 children are going to Beamish Museum as part of their History topic. Whilst there, the children will tour the museum visiting all the different parts of the site and take part in a Traditions of Christmas workshop, which focuses on the comparison of toys then and now at Christmas time. During the session, the children will make their own historical toys, hear stories and develop a clearer understanding of toys from this time.

Children will be travelling by coach, leaving St Anne's School at 9:15am and will be back to school for normal collection at 3:15pm. Children must wear non-uniform and wrap up warm with suitable footwear, winter coat, hat and gloves. As your child is in receipt of universal infant free school meals, they will receive a packed lunch from school. The teacher has already obtained their sandwich preference. If you do not want your child to have a school packed lunch and want them to bring their own, you **MUST** inform the school office no later than Friday 22nd November 2024.

The parental contribution for this trip is £15 (to cover activities and travel expenses). This trip will be available to book from 2pm on Friday 15th November 2024, if you have any difficulty accessing the Arbor app, please contact the school office.
